## General Position Statement

The primary purpose of the role is to undertake and provide specialist input into irrigation-related activities associated with the operation, optimisation and maintenance of community use areas.

The role contributes to the effective performance and water efficiency of irrigation systems, supporting high-quality, safe, and sustainable outcomes across parks, open spaces, sports fields, associated facilities, and other Council-managed assets throughout the Rockhampton Region.

## Specific Responsibilities

The successful candidate must be able to fulfil the following position responsibilities.

- Undertake day-to-day sports field irrigation operation and maintenance, including monitoring system performance and adjusting irrigation schedules to suit seasonal and turf requirements.
- Undertake and assist with the installation, programming, maintenance and repair of automated and manual irrigation systems, including valves, controllers, sprinklers, pumps and pipework, to ensure efficient water use and compliance with water restrictions and Council guidelines.
- Carry out routine inspections, diagnostics and troubleshooting of irrigation faults, including leaks, pressure issues, blockages and controller malfunctions, and complete reactive and preventative maintenance as required.
- Undertake and assist with soil moisture monitoring, soil testing and analysis, and contribute recommendations to improve turf health through effective irrigation scheduling and nutrient management programs.
- Support the Team Leader in delivering sports turf irrigation renewal and upgrade projects, including system audits, seasonal changeovers and water efficiency improvements.
- Provide specialist technical advice in irrigation systems, including advanced fault diagnosis, system optimisation, and water efficiency strategies.
- Identify, monitor and control turf pests, weeds and diseases, including the safe and compliant application of pesticides, herbicides and fungicides within the scope of training and certification.
