General Position Statement

This position supports Council's direction by working closely with the Team Leader to ensure the effective and efficient use of resources dedicated to sports turf operations. The primary aim of the role is to undertake and provide specialist input into sports turf and greenkeeping activities associated with the planning, preparation, development and ongoing maintenance of community sporting facilities.

Key duties include the implementation of mowing and presentation programs, operation and maintenance of irrigation systems, sports field renovations and recovery works, and the monitoring and management of turf pests, diseases, and weeds. The role contributes to the delivery of safe, high-quality, and fit for purpose playing surfaces across sports fields, parks, open spaces, and associated facilities throughout the Rockhampton Region.

Specific Responsibilities

The successful candidate must be able to fulfil the following position responsibilities.

- Support the Team Leader in the coordination of day to day sports turf maintenance activities to ensure playing surfaces meet agreed performance, safety and presentation standards.
- Undertake the preparation, maintenance and renovation of sports fields in accordance with approved work programs, including mowing regimes, irrigation management, fertiliser application, scarifying, aeration, topdressing, rolling and surface repairs.
- Operate sports turf maintenance plant and equipment, including cylinder mowers, zero-turn mowers, tractors, spray units and field renovation implements such as aerators, scarifiers, spreaders, Field top maker and Dakota top-dress unit.
- Provide technical advice and operational support to the Team Leader on sports turf maintenance activities, seasonal requirements and field recovery needs aligned with sporting codes and usage demands.
- Monitor turf condition, performance and wear patterns during daily operations and identify and recommend corrective actions to maintain safe high quality playing surfaces.
- Undertake soil sampling and testing activities, and implement fertiliser, soil amendment and irrigation programs as directed.

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- Undertake pest, weed and disease control activities using approved integrated turf management practices, including the safe operation of spray units and application of chemicals in accordance with training, licensing and procedures.
- Carry out the installation, operation, maintenance and minor repair of sports field irrigation systems to support effective water delivery and system efficiency.
- Conduct routine visual inspections of sports grounds and associated facilities, identifying hazards, defects or maintenance issues and reporting findings in accordance with procedures.
- Operate and maintain turf maintenance plant, machinery and vehicles safely and competently, including tractor operations and attached renovation implements, in accordance with Unit procedures and manufacturer guidelines.
- Complete daily pre-start inspections, servicing and safety checks of equipment and vehicles, ensuring accurate completion of service, maintenance and chemical application records.
- Provide on the job guidance and support to lower classified employees to develop skills and apply safe work practices as required.
- Support the implementation of safety plans, risk assessments and participating in pre-start talks prior to commencing sports turf works.
- Complete allocated work management requirements including job reporting, quality checks, safety documentation and time recording.
- Assist with the collection and recording of information for performance reporting relating to turf condition, field availability and maintenance activities.
- Contribute to sports turf improvement and upgrade projects by assisting with works delivery and providing operational input, including field renovations and surface improvement works.
- Identify and suggest opportunities for improving efficiency, turf performance and work practices to the Team Leader.
- Participate in job rotation and multi-skilling activities to support service delivery and workload requirements.
- Comply with and promote adherence to Unit procedures, operational standards and work health and safety requirements.
- Refer matters that may impact upon the business, Council and employees to the relevant Supervisor or Coordinator.
- Undertake other relevant duties as directed, consistent with skills, competence and training

Position Requirements

- Knowledge of the installation, operation maintenance and fault diagnosis of sports field irrigation systems, including water efficiency practices and system performance.
- Ability to provide technical advice and input to support sports turf maintenance programs, seasonal planning, and field recovery activities.
- Ability to work with a high degree of autonomy, prioritising tasks and adjusting work practices in response to site conditions and operational requirements.
- Understanding of soil health, nutrient management, and irrigation interactions to support turf performance and durability.
- Communicate Effectively – Ability to communicate with others verbally and in writing to meet requirements of the role.
- Teamwork and Collaboration – Ability to work together with others to achieve common goals both within immediate team and teams across Council.
- Time Management – Ability to plan and organise tasks/work to meet objectives of the role.

General Position Statement

This position supports Council's direction by working closely with the Sportsgrounds Maintenance Team Leader to ensure the effective and efficient use of resources dedicated to sportsgrounds maintenance. The primary aim of the role is to undertake specialist sports turf maintenance activities associated with the preparation, presentation, and ongoing upkeep of community sporting facilities.

Key duties include the delivery of mowing and presentation programs, operating and maintaining irrigation systems, implementing seasonal renovation and surface recovery works, and monitoring and managing turf pests, diseases, and weeds.

The role contributes to the provision of safe, high-quality, and fit for purpose playing surfaces across sportsgrounds, ovals, parks, open spaces, and associated facilities throughout the Rockhampton Region.

Specific Responsibilities

The successful candidate must be able to fulfil the following position responsibilities.

- Assist the Team Leader in coordinating daily sportsground maintenance activities to ensure playing surfaces meet required performance, safety and presentation standards.
- Undertake preparation, routine maintenance and renovation of sports fields and outfields in accordance with approved work programs, including mowing regimes, irrigation management, fertiliser application, aeration, scarifying, rolling, topdressing and surface repairs.
- Operate and maintain sportsground plant and equipment in accordance with operational procedures and manufacturer guidelines.
- Provide technical and operational support to the Team Leader in delivering sportsground maintenance activities
- Monitor turf condition, surface performance and wear patterns, and report issues or recommend corrective actions to maintain safe and high-quality playing surfaces.
- Assist with soil sampling and testing, and implement fertiliser, soil amendment and irrigation programs as directed.
- Undertake pest, weed and disease control using approved integrated turf management practices, ensuring safe handling and application of chemicals in accordance with licensing, training and procedures.

- Install, operate, maintain and carry out minor repairs on sportsground irrigation systems to support effective water use and system efficiency.
- Conduct routine inspections of sportsgrounds and associated facilities, identifying hazards, defects or maintenance issues and reporting them in line with procedures.
- Safely operate and maintain plant, machinery and vehicles, including tractors and attached implements, in accordance with operational procedures and manufacturer guidelines.
- Complete daily pre-start checks, servicing and safety inspections of equipment and vehicles, ensuring accurate records of maintenance and chemical applications are maintained.
- Provide on the job guidance and support to team members as required under the direction of the Team Leader.
- Assist in implementing safety plans, risk assessments and participate in pre-start meetings prior to commencing works.
- Complete required work management tasks including job reporting, quality assurance checks, safety documentation and time recording.
- Support the collection and recording of data for KPI reporting relating to turf condition, field usage and maintenance outputs.
- Contribute to sportsground improvement and upgrade projects, including field renovations and surface enhancement works.
- Identify opportunities to improve efficiency, turf performance and work practices, and communicate these to the Team Leader.
- Participate in job rotation and multi-skilling to support operational needs and service delivery.
- Comply with and promote adherence to operational procedures, organisational standards and work health and safety requirements.
- Refer matters that may impact upon the business, Council and employees to the relevant Supervisor or Coordinator.
- Undertake other relevant duties as directed, consistent with skills, competence and training.
